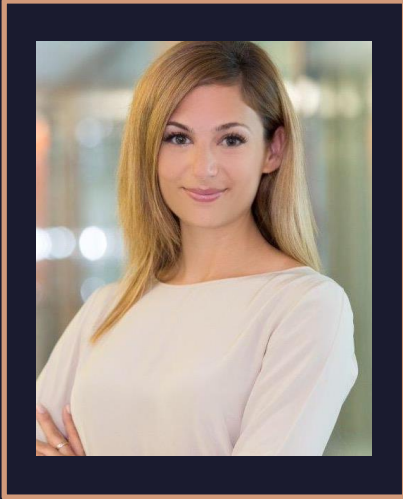




Valérie Parihar
